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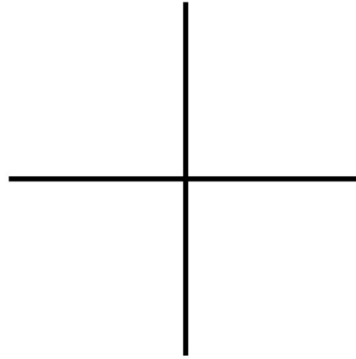
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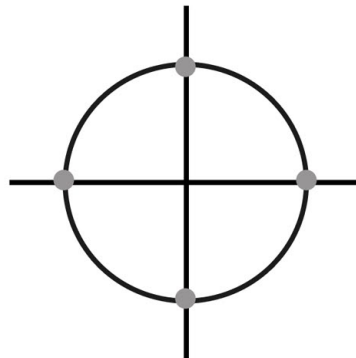


## Geometric Patterns - Drawing Five Overlapping Circles

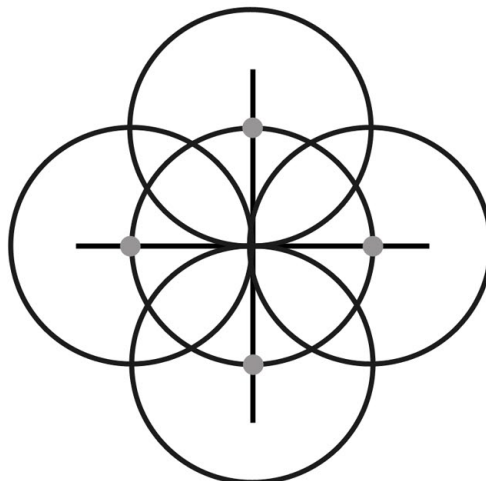
1. Use a ruler to draw two straight, perpendicular lines.



2. Put the point of a compass where the lines meet to draw a circle.

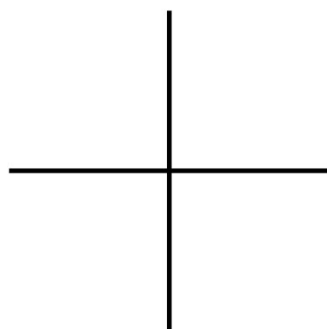


3. Put the point of the compass where each line meets the circle to draw four more circles.

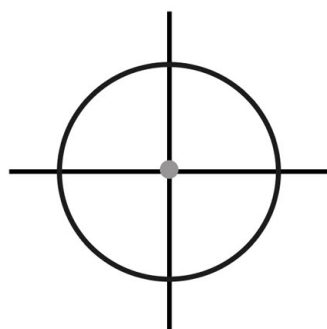


## Geometric Patterns - Drawing Seven Overlapping Circles

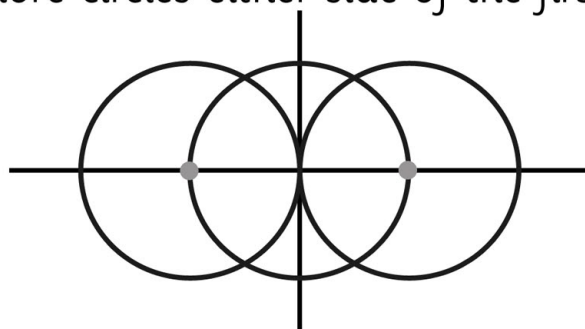
1. Use a ruler to draw two straight, perpendicular lines.



2. Use a compass to draw a circle.



3. Put the point of the compass where the lines meet to draw two more circles either side of the first.



4. Draw four more identical circles, placing the compass point where the circles meet.
