Session 1 Phonics/ English	<p>PHONICS: Watch the sight word rap and join in. Test your child on the spellings of some of these words. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=EOvWOWIfITs</p> <p>Explain that we are focusing on ey this week making the/ee/ phoneme. Watch the video can your child tell you where the ey comes in the words. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ju000Datow</p> <p>Write down some of the ey words from the video for your child to trace over with different coloured crayons over and over (Rainbow writing)</p> <p>ENGLISH:</p> <p>Over the next few weeks, we will be looking at Traditional stories. A traditional tale is a story that has been told and re-told for many years, and consequently, becomes a story that almost everyone knows. Traditional tales are also referred to as fairy stories or fairy tales.</p> <p>If you have the story of Snow White read it to your child and discuss the setting, characters and what happens in the beginning, middle and end.</p>	<p>PHONICS: See the link for Year One common exception words. Write down on paper or card some of the words your child might find tricky to read or spell. Hide in a room or around the house for your child to find. Can they read the word by sight? Turn it over can they spell the word.</p> <p>Practice writing ey in the air, on your back or on a tray of flour etc...</p> <p>Watch Geraldine. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=XDruUMOtZw</p> <p>Dictate the sentence: I have a key for the big red box.</p> <p>ENGLISH: Recap Snow white story from yesterday. One of the features of Traditional stories is to have a hero and a villain. Ask your child to draw and label pictures of the hero and Villain in this story.
