Session 1 Phonics/ English	<p>PHONICS: Watch the Phase five tricky word video. Watch again with no sound. Can you child read the words by sight? Can they put the words into a verbal sentence? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=DbcZnb2iz1c</p> <p>Recap a-e and e-e split digraph from previous weeks. Remind your child that the vowels are split apart with a bossy consonant in the middle. Watch video introducing i-e split digraph. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=4-swf36y_40</p> <p>Support your child to write some of the words from the video. Can they add the loop for the split digraph?</p> <p>ENGLISH: This week is book Week! As your child to choose their favourite book at home. Ask your child to read their book to or with someone in their family. Support your child to write a sentence or more to explain why it is your favourite book. Has your child used full stops, capital letters and finger spaces correctly?</p>	<p>PHONICS: Watch the Phase five tricky word video. Watch again with no sound.
