Session 1 Phonics/ English	<p>PHONICS: Join in singing recap song. Can your child recognise any graphemes and make the phoneme. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=YPW-ZkhRUPY</p> <p>Watch Mr Thorne introduce split digraph e-e https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=kFuETDoqVnA</p> <p>Support your child to write down some of the words Mr Thorne introduced. Ask your child to draw a loop to show the split digraph.</p> <p>ENGLISH: Explain that this week we are looking at the story 'Katie Morag and the New Pier'. Look at attached resource 'Katie Morag and the New Pier' Front cover. Ask your child 'What can you see? What do you think will happen? Where is it set? How do you know? Who are the characters?' Support your child (Or scribe) a prediction about this book. E.g. I think that this story will be about.....because.....</p>	<p>PHONICS: Join in singing recap song again. Can your child recognise any graphemes and make the phoneme. Can they think of other words which use the graphemes. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=YPW-ZkhRUPY</p> <p>Dictate the words to spell: Pete Concrete Compete Theme these</p> <p>ENGLISH: Watch and listen to the story of 'Katie Morag and the New Pier' https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=65U7COtatDo Use the cartoon strip attached resource or make your own. Support your child to draw the story in order. Can they use their cartoon strip to retell the story in their own words?</p>	<p>PHONICS: Use igh ay a-e stuck up on paper around the room. Find me the grapheme which makes thesound. Find me the grapheme in the word night. Etc....</p> <p>Dictate the sentences: Pete went to a theme park. He put concrete on the road.</p> <p>Has your child used finger spaces? Full stops and capital letters? Split digraph e-e?</p> <p>ENGLISH: Recap yesterday's story and have another go at retelling the story using their cartoon strip. Pause on a page with Katy Morag. Ask your child to draw a picture of Katy Morag. Can they describe her character to you using examples from the story. E.g Katy Morag is kind because she wanted to help the Ferrymen.</p>	<p>PHONICS: Play Tricky Word Trucks on Phonics play. (Jan21 home) Phase Five e-e https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources/phase/2/picnic-on-pluto</p> <p>ENGLISH: Look at attached resource. 'Katy Morag and the New Pier' Describe the scene. Ask your child to describe what is happening in the picture. Explain that adjectives are describing words. (We have learnt about these) Can the use adjectives in their sentences to describe the picture.</p>	<p>Use this session to explore 'Bug Club'</p> <p>ENGLISH: Watch the cursive handwriting video.
