### **English**

Set on assignments.

Monday - LO: I can recognise a narrative poem. Watch the PowerPoint and identify the features of a narrative poem in the activity sheet.

**Challenge:** Summarise what a narrative poem is in less than 30 words.

Tuesday/ Wednesday - LO: I can plan a narrative poem. Watch the PowerPoint and complete the storyboard activity. I suggest annotating the story one day, and drawing/colouring it another to make sure you really know the narrative well before you begin to write it up the next day.

**Challenge:** Why does a story board support the planning of a narrative?

Thursday/Friday - LO: I can write/edit a narrative poem. Watch the PowerPoint Videos The lessons are broken into 2 days and write your narrative poem. You will write the first verse Thursday, then complete and edit it on Friday.

**Challenge:** Pick a feature you have used. Explain the effect that has on the reader.

### **Guided Reading**

Monday - Reading for pleasure (any book or magazine of choice).

Tuesday - Spelling scribble **or** word search. Word search is located in **Files > Home Learning > 18<sup>th</sup> - 22<sup>nd</sup> January > Guided Reading.**

Wednesday - Read chapters **The BFG** and **The Giants**. Answer the VIPERS questions. Set as an assignment.

Thursday - 20 minute write: Write a character description about the lady in the picture. Set as an assignment.



Friday - Handwriting practise: Letter M. 1 line of capitals, 2 lines of lower case. Then write as many words with the letter m in. Which word can you think of that has a lot?... Mummy does!
