

## **Pupil Premium Policy for All Hallows CE Primary School**

This document explains how we spend our Pupil Premium Funding to make this value a reality for all young people.

Objectives for pupil premium at All Hallows CE Primary School

- 1.The Pupil Premium will be used to provide additional educational support to raise the standard of achievement for these pupils.
- 2.The funding will be used to narrow and close the gap between the achievement of these pupils and their peers.
- 3.As far as possible the school will use the additional funding to address any underlying inequalities between children eligible for Pupils Premium and others.
- 4.The school will ensure that the additional funding reaches the pupils who need it most and that it makes a significant impact on their education and lives.
- 5.The school will work closely with parents of pupil premium students to ensure that we collectively ensure the success of these students.

Strategies

- 1.The school staff have a joint role to support these children. Their role includes developing and implementing effective strategies to support this policy, monitoring the effectiveness of those strategies and keeping all stakeholders informed of progress.
- 2.The leadership team has responsibility for ensuring the school Pupil Premium Policy is implemented fully.
- 3.Pupil Premium will be clearly identifiable within the budget.
- 4.The Head teacher in consultation with the governors, staff and where appropriate, parents, will decide how the Pupil Premium is spent for the benefit of entitled pupils
- 5.The school will assess what additional provision should be made for the individual pupils.
- 6.The school will be accountable for how it has used the additional funding to support the achievement of those pupils covered by the Pupil Premium and the Head teacher will report to the governing body and parents on how effective the intervention has been in achieving its aims.
7. We will publish online information about how we have used the Premium.
- 8.We will ensure that parents, governors and others are made fully aware of the attainment of pupils covered by the Premium.
- 9.We will seek to further develop strategies and interventions which can improve the progress and attainment of these pupils.

10. We will track the impact of the strategies put into place through the funding to ensure that we can show the value that has been added to the education of the entitled children.

11. We will monitor, evaluate and review the success of the impact of the pupil premium funding.

#### Monitoring and evaluating

We will be monitoring and evaluating the achievement of our Pupil Premium students as a distinct cohort using our data checking system.
